### 1. BETTER DATA MANAGEMENT

Improve EPC database management with uniform data formats and accessible databases.



### 2. QUALITY CONTROL

Implement robust measures to ensure EPC accuracy and reliability.



### 3. ASSESSOR TRAINING

Develop training programs and verification mechanisms for EPC assessors.



### 4. PUBLIC AWARENESS

Conduct communication campaigns to highlight the value of EPCs.



### 5. AN INTEGRATED APPROACH

Link EPCs with initiatives like Renovation Passports for a comprehensive energy efficiency approach.
